### 1. Introduction

Amara NZero Group ("**Amara NZero**" or the "**Group**") formalises its commitment to respect and protect the environment by introducing pollution reduction and preservation of the natural and social environment in the development of its activities.

To this end, Amara NZero is committed to preventing pollution in all its forms, as well as to making sustainable use of natural resources and promoting the circular economy, considering the life cycle of the products consumed and supplied.

Amara NZero's leadership commitment as a strategic partner in the Energy Transition is aligned with the contribution to achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) six, seven, eleven, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and seventeen adopted by the United Nations.

### 2. Purpose and Scope

The objective of this Environmental Policy (the "**Policy**") is to establish the principles of action that promote the protection, conservation and restoration of the environment from a sustainable perspective and from environmental protection, a key factor in the development of Amara NZero's activity, which is achieved thanks to the responsibility and participation of all its members, allowing the development of its Mission, Vision and Values.

This Policy is applicable to all the companies that make up the Amara NZero Group, without prejudice to the approval of their own environmental policy, which must be aligned with the principles set out herein.

### 3. Principles of action

Amara NZero is committed to guide its actions according to the following fundamental principles:

**ENSURE** compliance with applicable legal, regulatory, contract and commercial agreements with all our stakeholders, as well as voluntary environmental requirements.

**PREVENT** environmental risks and emergencies, including those related to Climate Change, and implement effective mechanisms for their management. Identify opportunities to propose the necessary actions to increase the desirable effects.

**PROTECT** the environment and biodiversity, preventing pollution and minimising the real or potential impact on them, carrying out a strategy to avoid any type of pollution that could originate from operations due to our activity.

**TO KNOW** the context of the Company in order to identify, understand and satisfy the needs and expectations of the interested parties.

**PROMOTE** energy efficiency in our operations and reduce greenhouse gas emissions by adopting technologies and practices that minimise our carbon footprint.

**MINIMISE** waste generation by promoting and working towards a circular economy, encouraging the prevention of waste generation, its reuse, strengthening recycling and favouring its traceability.

**OPTIMISE** the consumption of natural resources by carrying out a sustainable use and considering the life cycle perspective of the products consumed and supplied.

**PROMOTE** communication and involvement of the entire Amara NZero team, as well as our stakeholders, promoting awareness and training in the respect and protection of the environment and the fight against climate change, involving them in the commitments and principles of the Policy.

**COMMUNICATE** clearly and honestly about the results and actions related to the environment.

**ENCOURAGE** continuous improvement, incorporating the best available technologies and R&D&I to reduce pollution and risks and take advantage of the most advantageous opportunities.
