

Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

Amara NZero Group ("**Amara NZero**" or the "**Group**") understands the importance of protecting personal data in accordance with the highest international standards to ensure that information is controlled and used responsibly.

In order to ensure compliance with these requirements, it defines the general common principles and guidelines for action that should govern the Group in the area of personal data protection.

This Policy is part of the information security management strategy of all the companies that are part of Amara NZero.

2. Purpose and scope

The purpose of this Privacy Policy (the "**Policy**") is to establish the technical, legal and organisational criteria and principles that guarantee the protection of the rights and freedoms of data subjects in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation of the European Union ("**GDPR**"), which Amara NZero establishes as the minimum standard of application, without prejudice to any other legislation on this matter that may be applicable in the territory of the companies of the Group.

This Policy is applicable to all companies that make up the Amara NZero Group without prejudice to the approval of their own privacy policy, which must be aligned with the principles set out herein.

3. Principios

Amara NZero commits itself to guide its actions according to the following fundamental principles:

LAWFULNESS, FAIRNESS AND TRANSPARENCY.

Amara NZero must inform about:

- The identity of the Data Controller.
- The contact details of the Data Controller.
- The contact details of the Data Protection Officer, if any.
- The purpose of the processing.
- The legitimation for the processing.
- The recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data.

- The envisaged transfers of personal data to third countries.
- The envisaged retention periods.
- The rights of the data subject and how to exercise them.
- The right to lodge a complaint with the data protection authority in each country.

PURPOSE LIMITATION

Amara NZero will collect and process data only for those purposes initially determined by the data subject, always explicit and legitimate.

DATA MINIMISATION

Amara NZero will only process data of data subjects that are necessary for the purpose for which they are collected and are adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed.

ACCURACY

Amara NZero will only process data that is accurate, and will take the appropriate actions to correct erroneous or incomplete data.

LIMITATION OF THE RETENTION PERIOD

Amara NZero will avoid the perpetual retention of data by setting a retention period from the time the data is no longer needed.

INTEGRITY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

Amara NZero will guarantee the integrity and confidentiality of personal data by implementing technical and organisational measures to maintain the security of the data, avoiding its alteration, loss, processing or unauthorised access, in accordance with the state of technology, the nature of the data and the possible risks to which they are exposed.

PROACTIVE RESPONSIBILITY (ACCOUNTABILITY)

Amara NZero must ensure an adequate level of protection in proportion to the risk posed by the data processing it handles and be in a position to demonstrate compliance with the provisions of the Regulation.
